

ROADS & GROUNDS COMMITTEE MEETING

1. **Call to Order & Citizen Comments** – Chairman Farnham called the meeting to order at 5:00pm. No citizen comments.
2. **Approval of Minutes-** Councilman Davis made a motion to approve the minutes from September 2, 2021. Chairman Farnham seconded the motion. Motion passed.
3. **2022 Preliminary Street Budget-** Mr. Doyle provided the committee with the 2022 Preliminary Street Budget for review. Some expenses include street improvements on Tribune, purchase of a side by side and a trailer.
4. **Leaf and Limb Dump-** Mr. Doyle stated that Dr. Reznicek owner of Reznicek Dental in Waynesville came to sign out key to the Leaf and Limb Dump to dispose of yard waste from Reznicek Dental which is inside the city limits but was told no because he did not reside within City limits. Mr. Doyle would like to amend ordinance to include property owners within City limits to be able to have access to the Leaf and Limb dump. Councilman Davis made a motion to amend ordinance to state the lawn and leaf dump facility is free to residents and property owners within the City limits of Waynesville. Chairman Farnham seconded the motion. Motion passed.
5. **Project Updates-** Mr. Doyle provided pictures to the committee of all the completed projects. These projects included repairing the walking path under the Roubidoux Bridge, cleaning up debris at the Laughlin Park handicap fishing area and planting trees at the Roubidoux Park that were provided by the Forestry ReLeaf Program. Mr. Doyle also discussed the resolution that was passed to get the speed limit changed on Route 66 going down the hill. Mr. Doyle is working with traffic engineer to see if change can be made.
6. **Street Department Updates-** Jason Chapman stated that the Street Department has been working on Pinnacle St, prepping Industrial Park Rd to get ready for paving, planted trees at the park, cleaned Laughlin Park handicap fishing area and repaired walking path under Roubidoux bridge.
7. **Other Business**
  - i. **November Committee Meetings Schedule-** Due to Veterans Day on November 11, committee meetings have been rearranged for the month of November. November 2 will be Utility and Finance. November 3 will be Economic Development & Governmental Affairs. November 4 will be Emergency Service & Police and Roads & Grounds.
