



WSR Youth Sports Scholarship Requirements

WSR Youth Sports provides need-based scholarship to several youth participants each year. Scholarships are provided on a first-come first-serve basis, and are not guaranteed.

Eligibility Requirements:

- ✓ Complete WSR Youth Sports Scholarship Application (attached)
- ✓ Provide most recent tax return, showing annual household income of less than \$18,000, or proof of current receipt of unemployment insurance
- ✓ Minimum of a C average for school-aged children

WSR Youth Sports Scholarship Application and documentation for proof of eligibility is due to the WSR Youth Sports office for review no later than *one week prior the registration deadline*. Final scholarship funding determinations will be made by the registration deadline.

Once awarded a WSR Youth Sports Scholarship:

WSR Youth Sports participants are allowed a maximum of one (1) scholarship per year, per child. No more than four (4) scholarships will be awarded to any household in a calendar year.

If, at any point, the child's grades drop below a C average or he/she gets in any trouble (either with law enforcement or at school), he/she will be dropped from the team and will be ineligible for another scholarship for 24 months.

If awarded a scholarship, your child will be required to write a thank you letter to a community partner that is sponsoring him/her in the chosen sport.

What does a WSR Youth Sports Scholarship cover?

Scholarship funds will cover all registration costs, which generally covers:

For certain sports, additional equipment and/or uniform pieces may be required to be purchased. On a case-by-case basis, if your school-aged child maintains an A average, he/she may be eligible for additional funding to cover these costs.

He/She further understands that, if awarded a Scholarship, he/she will be required to write a thank you letter to a community partner that is sponsoring him/her in the chosen sport.
