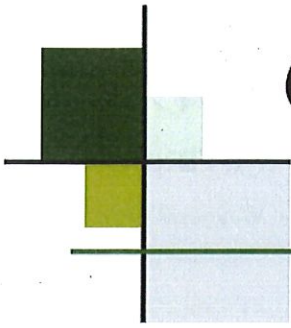

Completed applications will be reviewed by the Economic Development Committee on a monthly basis. The committee will choose one local business to spotlight per month. The committee will be taking into consideration the business's growth and development, its reputation in the community, and its generosity in giving back to community and charitable organizations. Incomplete applications, or any applications that do not conform to the listed Eligibility Requirements will not be considered. Businesses may only be chosen once every three years.

- Business must be located within the City Limits of Waynesville, MO
- Business must have two consecutive years of operation
- Business must be in good standing with the Secretary of State's Office
- Business must be current on City/County taxes, business license and all utility fees
