Connects wires and transformers using a variety of splices, connectors, sleeves or clamps.  Installs, removes, transfers, maintains and repairs cross arms, pins and other overhead pole and URD equipment using a variety of handtools, equipment and power tools.  Routes and re-routes power lines over, under or around existing lines using "hot line" tools.  Inspects lines, poles and equipment for signs of wear or damage. Reports deficiencies.  Assists in the construction and maintenance of power lines.</p>
