

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 315 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE  
CITY OF WAYNESVILLE REGARDING VEHICLE TURNING MOVEMENTS;  
FIXING AN EFFECTIVE DATE**

**WHEREAS**, in order to protect the safety and well-being of its citizens, the City of Waynesville recognizes the need to establish restrictions regarding the use of two-way traffic lanes within City limits; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Waynesville amends Chapter 315 of the existing traffic code to include such restrictions for the good of the public.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WAYNESVILLE AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The following section shall be added to Chapter 315 of the City of Waynesville Municipal Traffic Code:

**315.040: DESIGNATED TWO-WAY LEFT TURN LANES**


Where a special lane for making left turns by drivers proceeding in opposite directions have been indicated by official traffic control devices:

- A. A left turn shall not be made from any other lane.
- B. A vehicle shall not be driven in the lane except when preparing for or making a left turn from or into the roadway or when preparing for or making a U-turn when otherwise permitted by law.
- C. A vehicle shall not be driven in the lane for a distance more than one hundred (100) feet.

**Section 3.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of its passage.
