Open Session Minutes

Call to Order: Mayor Hardman called the March 10th, 2020 special session meeting of the Waynesville City Council to order at 5:00pm.

Roll Call: On roll call, Mayor Hardman and six (6) council members were present and a quorum was established:

There was a need for a closed session. Councilman France made a motion to move to closed session, seconded by Councilman Wilson.

Invocation & Pledge of Allegiance: Invocation was given by Councilman Mike Curtis with the Pledge of Allegiance being led by Mayor Hardman.

Approval of the Agenda: Mayor Hardman called for a motion to approve the agenda. A motion was made by Councilman France and seconded by Councilman Curtis to approve the agenda.

PROPOSED ORDINANCE #2405: An Ordinance Authorizing the Mayor to Enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of St. Robert to jointly negotiate an asset purchase with Zeigenbein Sanitation was provided to Council for review. Mr. Harrill stated that this agreement would allow the cities to work with the City of St. Robert to negotiate a purchase of the assets of Zeigenbein Sanitation, in order for the cities to offer solid waste services to their citizens without having to sub-contract the service. The proposed ordinance was read by title two (2) times and its adoption and passage was moved by Councilman Liberty and seconded by Councilman Wilson.
