The Electric Department keeps everything running in Waynesville. Supervisor Daniel Sheldon has a department of five. We have five feeder lines powering the city, with 2091 residential customers and 269 commercial. They are always ready to respond to outages. In the last two months, they have been rebuilding the "A" Feeder line destroyed by the May flooding. They have re-routed service to the new Middle School annex. Responding to any call, the department is vital to the City and its' citizens.



Our 3.2 MW Solar Farm is a new addition to the Waynesville electric system and offers renewable and reliable energy to the City. When you flip the light switch remember these "everyday heroes" who literally light up our lives!

CITY COUNCIL NOTES


