**CITY COUNCIL NOTES**


- \*recognized Suzanne Wilber as a "Good Citizen" for her work with Good Samaritan and welcomed Mrs. MO-USA, Waynesville resident, Chelsea Smith-George
- \*seated a new council and swore in new members, Sean Wilson, Ward 3 and Bill Farnham, Ward 1
- \*reported \$3.38 million in reserve and restricted accounts

- \*passed an ordinance requiring sewer backflow preventers on new construction and certain renovations

**INTERNET USE TAX UPDATE**

In April of 2018, the citizens overwhelmingly approved the collection of Internet Sales Tax monies by the city. In our budget for 2019, we estimated we would receive \$40,000. In the first three months of 2019, we have already received \$52,400.

This money is earmarked for road work and storm water drainage projects. As the year progresses and we realize what funds we will have to work with, the council will prioritize that work.

Thank you to the citizens for being foresighted in collecting this sales tax that is already collected by Internet vendors!
