## 2020 GOALS AND BUDGET

The City's 2020 budget is \$20.9 million and after many discussions of goals and objectives for the year, key projects were identified. State law mandates that a City's budget must be balanced and the City spends several months making sure that everything of importance is planned for, along with providing money for emergency responses throughout the year.

2020 will see the extension of the Roubidoux Walking Trail. With a grant of \$88,000, the trail will wind through downtown and connect to Laughlin Park. This grant also includes another handi-capped accessible bathroom in the eastern section of the main park.



Other items include a new police car, a lease purchase for a fuel truck at the airport, prioritized street paving, several projects at the airport using grant monies. The budget was approved in Nov.


