City Staff talks Budget 2021

City Administrator, John Doyle and Finance Officer, Amber Box have been working steadily with departments of the City during the past month on the draft 2021 budget. This being Mr. Doyle's first year tackling the budget for the City of Waynesville, he has enjoyed working with City staff during the budgeting process. "We have went through sev-

eral of the departments' budgets and have around five departments left to review. An additional budget meeting will occur at the end of September for the Electric Department; however, budget talks with other Department Supervisors and staff have gone extremely well."

City Staff plan on presenting the 2021 budget to the Council's Committees during October for review with a final draft budget ready for City Council at the November meeting.

City's Focus on Grant Funding Pays Off

City Administrator John Doyle advised the City Council at the September's meeting that several grants have been awarded to the City funding various projects.

The City will receive approximately \$9,506 from the Non-Playground Scrap Tire Mate-

rial Grant through Missouri DNR that will provide the Parks with ADA accessible tables and benches. The City received funds of \$22,262 from SEMA, for damages the City sustained during the 2017 flood.

The Waynesville Police Department was awarded \$24,500 in grant funding to conduct DWI and Hazardous Moving Violations Saturations during the holidays.

Parking Violation Fees Amended

The Waynesville City Council approved an amendment to the City's parking violation fee which will update to State's Uniform Fine Schedule. City Attorney Ralph Muxlow proposed the amendment which will pertain to all "limited" or "no parking" areas that are located throughout the City. Parking violation notices will be left with the offending vehicle and owners will have thirty (30) days to pay the fine of \$25.00. If the fine is not paid within the 30 day time period, the violation will be forwarded to the Municipal Court for processing.
